Sunday was a day that promised many things but in the end delivered little after a disappointing Grand Final loss to St Kilda City.

After finishing the home and away season on top of the ladder, with only one loss for the season, winning the second semi-final comfortably and having the week off, the team was looking forward to a positive grand final showing. On a disappointing surface (for a grand final), at Mentone Grammar Playing Fields, the boys struggled to play their best football on the shifting surface only showing glimpses of what they can do throughout the day. Our opponents kicked the first couple of goals but we managed to peg back the momentum going into the quarter time break and after an encouraging 10 minutes of football in the second quarter with goals to Marcus, Beery and Lachie M we went into the half time break down by only 2 points.
